Why is my laptop battery not showing up?

If selecting On for the Power option does not display the battery icon or the Power option is grayed out, try Option 2 below. Connect the AC adapter to your laptop and plug it into a power outlet. Open the Device Manager. Expand the list for the Batteries entry. Right-click the battery and select Disable device.

How do I Fix my laptop battery not showing up?

Open the Device Manager. Expand the list for the Batteries entry. Right-click the battery and select Disable device. Wait 10 seconds, then right-click the battery and select Enable. Restart the laptop. If Option 2 does not display the battery icon in the notification area, try Option 3 below. Open the Task Manager.

Why can't I see the battery icon on Windows 10?

If you can't see the battery icon on the Windows notification area, it might be a system setting issue. You can follow the steps below to help resolve the issue: Press and hold or right-click an empty area on the taskbar and select the Settings option.

Why is my battery icon not showing in Windows notification area?

If the battery icon is not displayed in the Windows Notification Area, select your version of Windows from the list below and follow the instructions. If these steps do not resolve your issue, a group policy setting may prevent the battery power icon from being displayed.

What if my laptop doesn't have a battery?

If your laptop thinks there's no battery present, perform a full shutdown, unplug the power cable, and physically remove the battery. Then, place the battery back in, reconnect the charging cable, and then power on your laptop.

Why does Windows 11 say no battery is detected?

If the error remains, it could be caused by a corrupted battery driver. In that case, you can try uninstalling the driver instead. Restart your PC after that to allow Windows to install the removed driver again. At times, issues with your PC's BIOS can also lead to the "No battery is detected" message on Windows 11.
