



Charging display battery

How do I know if a battery has been charged?

Simply click on the BatteryBar in the taskbar to toggle between time remaining and percentage. Hover the mouse over the BatteryBar percentage to see information about the actual capacity of the battery, discharge rate, remaining time, full runtime, battery wear, and elapsed time since the last charge.

How do I enable the battery percentage display?

To access the battery settings and enable the battery percentage display, follow these steps: Click on the Start menu icon, typically located in the lower-left corner of your screen. In the Start menu, click on the settings icon, which resembles a gear. In the Settings window, click on the "System" category.

How to show battery percentage on Windows 10?

Scroll down to the Battery section and toggle the switch next to Battery percentage to enable it. Click on the battery icon in the taskbar. Select More Power Options. How do I find the battery icon on Windows 10?

Shift the toggle button next to Power to the On position. The icon should appear instantly. If the icon still isn't visible, click the arrow icon on your Taskbar to show hidden icons, and click on the Battery icon. If the Show hidden icons option didn't help, type in Task Manager in the search box in the Start menu and open it.

How do I add a battery icon to my taskbar?

To add the battery icon to the taskbar: Select Start > Settings > Personalization > Taskbar, and then scroll down to Notification area. Select Select which icons appear on the taskbar, and then turn on the Power toggle. Note: The Power toggle is not visible on a system such as a desktop PC that doesn't use battery power.

When you have under 20% battery remaining, the icon turns red. When your iPhone is charging, the battery icon turns green. This setting has been available on Touch ID-equipped iPhone models for years.
