As Chinese battery companies now explore the global market, the export volume of batteries continues to increase.

In the first three months, China's lithium battery exports reached 109.79 billion yuan (\$17.2 billion), a yearly growth of 94.3 percent, according to data from the General Administration of Customs. The export surge took place throughout last year.

What percentage of auto-use electric batteries are exported in China?

In the first three quarters, China's exports of auto-use electric batteries totaled 89.8 GWh, up 120.4 percent year-on-year, accounting for 88.7 percent of all battery exports, according to statistics from the China Automotive Power Battery Industry Innovation Alliance, released on October 11.

Does China have a battery industry?

China's battery materials and EV technology applications continue to make breakthroughs. The country now has formed the world's largest battery manufacturing value chain, extending from material research and development, battery production, recycling to equipment support, analysts said.

What percentage of the battery market is based on China?

According to data released by South Korean battery market research firm SNE Research, in 2022, Chinese enterprises accounted for 60.4 percent of the market share of the top 10 global battery companies in terms of capacity. Chinese battery manufacturers are also ramping up production with a focus on technological advancement.

How big is China's battery manufacturing capacity in 2022?

According to Aditya Lolla, China's battery manufacturing capacity in 2022 was 0.9 terawatt-hours, which is roughly 77% of the global share. Lolla is the Asia programme lead for Ember, a UK-based energy think-tank. Although the term "new three" is relatively fresh, the surge of the trio - all key to decarbonisation - has been a long time coming.

China has been the single largest consumer of lithium-ion (or li-ion) batteries for five consecutive years. It is also the world's undisputed king of battery production, with China's largest battery manufacturer Contemporary Amperex Technology Co. (CATL) alone holding around 35 percent of the global li-ion battery market in the first quarter of 2022.
