What is China's largest solar plant?

China continues its relentless expansion of solar power capacity, now home to the world's largest solar plant. The 2.2 gigawattfacility spans an area of over 25 square kilometers in the Gobi desert. This \$3 billion flagship project demonstrates the epic scale of renewable infrastructure developing worldwide.

Where is China's new solar power plant located?

The plant, situated in the Yalong River Basinof the Tibetan Autonomous Prefecture of Garze in southwest China's Sichuan Province's Yajiang County, will cover the needs of 700,000 households for a whole year with its annual generating capacity of 2 billion kilowatt-hours (kWh).
