



How to install the filter pump battery panel

How do you connect a solar panel to a pool pump?

Attach your solar panels to the mounting brackets. Connect the solar panels to a charge controller to regulate the power output. Connect the charge controller to a battery to store excess energy. Connect the battery to an inverter to convert the DC power to AC power. Connect the inverter to your pool pump.

How do I Turn on the filter pump?

Press the MENU button, air temperature falls below 38°F; F (3°C) and will automatically turn on the filter pump to circulate the water. CANCEL button; use the arrow keys to advance program is already entered, highlight CHANGE to DIMMERS and press ENTER.

How do I choose solar panels for my pool pump?

Another factor to consider when choosing solar panels is the size of your pool pump. Make sure to select panels that can generate enough power to meet your pump's requirements. Additionally, look for panels with a high efficiency rating and a warranty of at least 25 years.

How can the control panel be mounted on the pump?

The control panel can be mounted on the pump in four different directions in order to provide the user the best access. The control panel can also be mounted in a more convenient location with the help of the keypad relocation kit (P/N 356904Z).

How do I start a pool pump?

Press Start/Stop to start the pump. The pump will enter into priming mode (if enabled) and speed up to the maximum speed set in the pump menu settings. When water comes out of the filter air relief valve, close the valve. The system should now be free of air and recirculating water to and from the pool.

How do I install solar panels?

Here are the basic steps for installing solar panels: Choose a location for your solar panels that receives the most sunlight. Install mounting brackets on your roof or other surface. Attach your solar panels to the mounting brackets. Connect the solar panels to a charge controller to regulate the power output.

Plumb the back-up pump to the primary pump piping using a 1-1/2" Female Adapter (D), 45° Street Elbow (E) and a Wye fitting (F). It is highly recommended to do a "dry fit"
