Iraq signed a deal with TotalEnergies to install a 1,000 MW solar power plant. Iraqi bureaucrats have indicated that the arrangement with Masdar would help escalate the country's target of achieving 20%-25% of the energy produced from renewables.

In 2021, the Rumaila gas-fired combined-cycle power plant, undertaken by POWERCHINA, connected to the national grid, easing power shortages in southern Iraq. Moving forwards, plans are for POWERCHINA to continue to give full play to its know-how and experience to help with Iraq's reconstruction.
