How do I drain residual electricity from a non-removable battery?

How may I drain residual electricity from new device with non-removable battery. Does information posted elsewhere for non DELL device apply to my DELL. Shut down the computer. Unplug the computer from the wall socket. If the battery is removable, Remove the battery and hold the Power button down for 15 seconds.

How do I remove a battery from my computer?

Shut down the computer. Unplug the computer from the wall socket. If the battery is removable, Remove the battery and hold the Power button down for 15 seconds. If the battery is non-removable, while the computer is ON, hold the power button down and wait for the computer to shut down and still hold the power button down for another 15 seconds.

How do I disable the built-in battery on my ThinkPad?

From the user manual: To disable the built-in battery, do the following: Turn off your computer and disconnect the ac power adapter and all cables from the computer. Turn on your computer. When the logo screen is displayed, immediately press F1 to enter ThinkPad Setup. Select Config ? Power. The Power submenu is displayed.

How do I fix a bad battery?

1) Uninstalled all battery drivers and reinstalled them. 2) Shut off the machine, removed the battery. Rebooted with only power cord, then shut off insert battery and reboot. 3) Run a battery report The battery is only 2 months old and has approximately 60 charge cycles. How to disable built-in battery?

Depending on the model, the option to disable built in battery should be seen under Configuration tab similar to battery-in service mode to switch . Other older models may not have this option just to set expectations. Just an observation but I can give you 2 good reasons why I would break that puppy out of storage and start using it. 1.

How do I Reset my laptop battery?
