If the battery level is above 90%, the system will not charge the battery. You can try a system reset (power off, remove base cover, disconnect the battery and hold the power button for 30 sec, reconnect and try booting again. If you still see the same error, replace the battery.

6 ???· Still in Settings, open System > Battery > Battery usage by app. This will tell you which apps are using the most battery and you can make a decision what to do, whether to let Windows decide if it should run in the background while not sacrificing battery ...

If the capacity has dropped significantly since you bought the computer, there might be a problem. Similarly, Mac owners can open System Settings > Battery and see its status under Battery Health ...

If your laptop only receives power when the charger is plugged in, this means the battery is unable to charge or can"t hold a charge. Shut down the laptop and remove the battery, then wait for a few minutes before putting it back in and turning things on again. If the battery still won"t charge, you may need to get a replacement.
