

Where to replace the fire module battery

How to replace battery in a gas fireplace?

Carefully access the battery compartment once the fireplace is turned off and cooled. You may need a small screwdriver to open the compartment if it's screwed shut. After opening it, remove the old batteries, taking note of how they are oriented so you can insert the new ones correctly. Now, insert the fresh batteries into the compartment.

Before you get started, gather the following tools and supplies to make the process smoother: Fresh batteries (check your manual for the specific type: AA, AAA, or 9V are standard).

How do you replace a fire alarm case?

On this model, this involves unscrewing the case, removing the D battery from the slot, sliding a new one in (properly aligned, of course), then screwing the case back on. The case lid is attached to the ceiling by several electrical wires that connect to the building's central fire alarm system.

How do you remove a smoke detector battery?

To remove the smoke detector, turn it counterclockwise release it from the mounting bracket. Grip the whole top of the smoke detector and turn it about a half inch to release it. Once removed, you can pull it straight off to reveal the chamber where the battery is housed, allowing you to remove the old battery.
